

# ART IN THE PORONGURUP 2021

## CONDITIONS of ENTRY:

1. Competition is in 2 sections. **OPEN** – 16 years and over. **YOUTH** – 18 years and under. **OPEN** \$20 per entry. **YOUTH** \$15 per entry.
2. 16,17,18 Year olds may enter both sections but with separate exhibit.
3. Entry forms must be in by 19th March. All sections of the form must be completed and marked 'for sale' or 'not for sale'.
4. 20% commission on sales goes to the Friends of the Porongurup Range, Inc.
5. No more than three entries per person or group. An entry may have multiple pieces with a cohesive theme.
6. Exhibit must be the artist's original work and not have won a prize in any previous art competition.
7. It is the artist's responsibility to ensure that their work is not subject to libel, defamation of character, or in violation of copyright laws.
8. Entry is to be sculptural, broadly defined as a 3-dimensional exhibit.
9. Entry must be durable to withstand display outdoors.
10. Artists are requested not to display personal logos, sponsors or commercial entity around the sculpture. This information/material may be left at the entry desk for display.
11. Artist are responsible for the installation of their own works. Please advise coordinator if you would like to inspect the site for selection of position or need any assistance with installation. The manner of installation should respect the natural setting of the exhibition site. **Set up times 9am – 5pm Thursday 1st April** unless prior arrangement has been made.
12. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist at all times. The Friends of the Porongurup Range Inc. does not cover malicious damage insurance for any work in the exhibition, nor does it insure those persons installing and de-stalling works. The Friends of the Porongurup Range Inc holds no responsibility for damage caused to works during transportation to the exhibition site, installation, de-installation and while the works are on display.

13. To protect the environment, artist/s will remove all packaging, tools and equipment from the site when installation and de-installation is complete. Small, loose decorations eg. Sparkles, streamers etc must not be used.
14. For security purposes, no access will be permitted to the exhibition area between **5pm – 9am** unless by prior arrangement. The site will be monitored 24 hours a day throughout the event.
15. The Friends of the Porongurup Range Inc reserves the right to reproduce images of works for promotional, marketing or educational purposes.
16. Artwork can be available for sale with a commission of 20% of selling price payable to the Friends of the Porongurup Range Inc. Please include sale price of exhibit on form. Organisers ask that you do not use POA, the exhibit should be marked **For Sale or Not for sale**.
17. Exhibits can only be removed by artists or purchasers **after presentations** on Saturday April 10. If unable to collect on this day, please make written arrangements for someone to do so, on your behalf. No responsibility will be taken for art works remaining on site after 5pm pm April 10 2021.
18. Public votes will close at 5pm on Friday April 9. The Awards Presentation will be held at 11am on Saturday April 10 at the Art in the Porongurup site at Karribank with refreshments to follow. Artists, family and friends are welcome.
19. The Judging Panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Lobbying the judges will result in instant disqualification.
20. Works deemed unsafe or do not match the organisers " Terms and Conditions" may be excluded from the exhibition.
