

ART IN THE PORONGURUP 2022

Entry Terms and Conditions

1. Competition is in two sections: **OPEN** – 16 years and over. **YOUTH** – 18 years and under.

Entry fees: **OPEN** \$20 per entry **YOUTH** \$15 per entry

Youth aged 16,17 and 18 may enter both sections but with a separate exhibit.

Entry forms must be in by **8 April 2022**

All sections of the form must be completed and marked 'for sale' or 'not for sale'.

20% commission on sales goes to the Friends of the Porongurup Range, Inc.

No more than three entries per person or group. An entry may include multiple pieces with a cohesive theme.

2. Exhibit must be an original work of the artist and not have won a prize in any previous art competition. It is the artist's responsibility to ensure that their work is not subject to libel, defamation of character or in violation of copyright laws.

Entry is to be sculptural, broadly defined as a 3-dimensional exhibit.

Artists are requested not to display personal logos, sponsors or commercial entity around the sculpture. This information/material may be left at the entry desk for display.

3. Artists are responsible for the installation of their works. Please advise co-ordinator if you would like to inspect the site for selection of position or need any assistance with installation. The manner of installation should respect the natural setting of the exhibition site. **Set up times: 9am – 5pm Thursday, 14 April** unless prior arrangement is made.

4. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist at all times. The Friends of the Porongurup Range Inc. does not cover malicious damage insurance for any work in the exhibition nor does it insure those persons installing and de-installing works. The Friends of the Porongurup Range Inc holds no responsibility for damage caused to works during transportation to the exhibition site, installation, de-installation and while the works are on display.

To protect the environment, artist/s will remove all packaging, tools & equipment from the site when installation and de-installation is complete. Small, loose decorations eg. sparklers, streamers etc must not be used.

5. For security purposes, no access will be permitted to the exhibition area between **5pm – 9am** unless by prior arrangement. The site will be monitored 24 hours a day throughout the event.

6. The Friends of the Porongurup Range Inc reserves the right to reproduce images of works for promotional, marketing or educational purposes.

7. Artwork can be available for sale with a commission of 20% of selling price payable to the Friends of the Porongurup Range Inc. Please include sale price of exhibit on form. Organisers ask that you do not use POA; the exhibit should be marked **For Sale or Not for sale**.

8. Exhibits can only be removed by artists or purchasers **after presentations Saturday 23 April**. If unable to collect on this day, please make written arrangements for someone to do so on your behalf. No responsibility will be taken for art works remaining on site after 5pm pm 23 April 2022.

9. Public votes will close at **5pm Friday 22 April**. The **Awards presentations will be held at 11am on Saturday 23 April** in the Porongurup Hall with refreshments to follow. Artists, family and friends are welcome.

10. Works deemed unsafe or do not match the organisers " Terms and Conditions" may be excluded from the exhibition.
